

## Find someone who ... (Speaking and grammar)

- Description:** A walk-around activity to ask each other questions, with a subsequent reporting phase.
- Use with or after:** *English Network 1 (New Edition)*, Unit 2, Step 2.
- Skill:** Speaking and grammar
- Focus:** Students ask each other questions with *do*, and then report in the third person singular.
- Time:** 10 minutes
- Preparation:**
- Print out both pages of this file.
  - Make a copy of the second page for each student, and one for yourself so you can do the activity with them.
  - Prepare a big card, preferably yellow, with a big letter **S** on it, to use for making corrections.
- Procedure:**
- Give each student a copy of the worksheet and remind them how to answer *Do*-questions, with *Yes, I do* or *No, I don't*.
  - Ask them to stand up, taking the worksheet and a pen or pencil with them, and something hard to write on such as their textbook.
  - They walk around and ask each other questions with *Do ...*, such as *Do you eat a lot of fish?* When someone answers *Yes, I do* they should write that person's first name on their sheet.
  - They should ask no more than two questions at each encounter, so that they talk to as many people as possible.
  - After about five minutes, ask the students to sit down and report on what they have found out, for instance: *Maria eats a lot of fish. Heinz drinks tea every morning.* Hold up your **S**-card if someone forgets to put the -s on the verb.
