

## Cities puzzle (Vocabulary and listening)

- Description:** A puzzle using words from the dialogue "An evening for the tourists"
- Use with or after:** *English Network 1 (New Edition)*, Unit 5, Step 1.
- Skill:** Vocabulary and listening
- Focus:** Remembering words from the dialogue.
- Time:** 10 minutes
- Preparation:**
- Print out all three pages of this file and make enough copies of the second page so that each student can have one.
  - Make enough copies of the key (third page) so that every second student can have one.
- Procedure:**
- Ask the students to read along in their books as you replay the recording of the dialogue "An evening for the tourists" from Unit 5 Step 1 of *English Network 1 (New Edition)*, text CD 2, track 9.
  - Then ask them to close their books. Distribute the puzzle and point out the nine sentences at the bottom of the page. The missing word in each sentence (indicated by a tilde ~) is the word they need for the puzzle. Ask them to fill in as many of the words as they can from memory.
  - Play the recording again (with their books closed) and ask them to listen for any words that they might be missing from the puzzle.
  - Finally, give every second student a copy of the key so they can check their answers together.
