

Paris crossword (Grammar)

Description: Students solve a crossword about a very short visit to Paris.

Use with or after: *English Network 2 (New Edition)*, Unit 5, Step 1.

Skill: Grammar

Focus: Use of *anybody, everywhere, somebody*, etc.

Time: 10 minutes

Preparation:

- Print out both pages of this file.
- Make a copy of the second page for each student.

Procedure:

- Ask the class if any of them have been to Paris. Those who have been there should each say a sentence or two about their visit.
- Give each student a copy of the crossword. They should try to find the missing words in the white squares individually, and then compare with a partner.
- Alternatively, you could assign this crossword as homework.

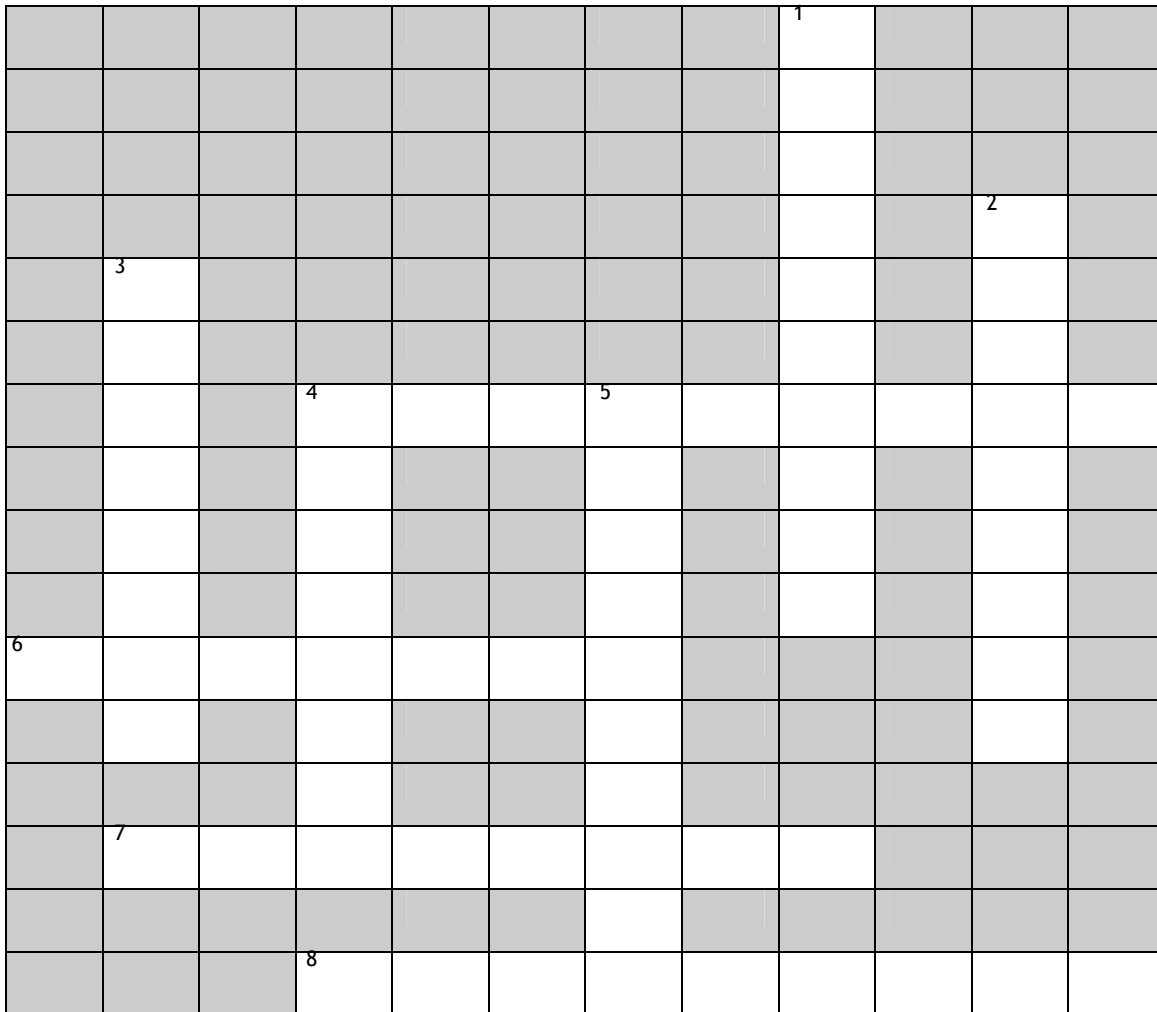
Key:
