

## Do you do it yourself?

(Speaking and grammar)

**Description:** Partner interview.

**Use with or after:** *English Network Connection*, Unit 9.

**Skill:** Speaking and grammar.

**Focus:** Questions and answers in three tenses with the causative *have*.

**Time:** 15 minutes

**Preparation:**

- Print out both pages of this file.
- Make a copy of the second page for each student.
- Think of some things that you have **had done** lately, so that you can give examples if needed. Perhaps you have *had your bicycle repaired*, *had your car washed*, *had your flat painted*, or whatever.

**Procedure:**

- In pairs, the students take turns asking each other questions and noting down their partner's answers on the form, e.g. *Do you cut your hair yourself? How often do you have your hair cut? Where do you have your hair cut? When did you last have your hair cut? When are you going to have your hair cut?* etc.
- When monitoring this, pay particular attention to their word order in the questions and answers, and be prepared to translate things that they *have had done* but don't have the English vocabulary for.
- As the pairs finish, put them together in groups of four and ask them to compare their results. The groups can then report some of the more interesting results to the whole class.
