

How people can look or feel (Vocabulary)

- Description:** Students write their own clues to a crossword, for other students to solve.
- Use with or after:** *English Network Plus (New Edition)*, Unit 2.
- Skill:** Vocabulary
- Focus:** Revision of vocabulary relating to how people can look or feel.
- Time:** 10 minutes
- Preparation:**
- Print out the second and third pages of this file (crosswords A and B) and make enough copies so that each student can have one or the other, but not both.
 - Cut on the dotted lines to remove the keys.
- Procedure:**
- Divide the class into two groups, A and B, and have the groups sit as far apart as possible, on opposite sides of the room.
 - Give each person a copy of the appropriate crossword (A or B) and point out that the clues to the crosswords are missing.
 - If your class has not done this sort of activity before, you may wish to elicit some examples of what such a clue could be, such as a definition or explanation, a drawing, an example sentence with a gap, or *the same as*, *the opposite of*, *a kind of*. Collect some examples on the board, e.g.
- *land with water on all sides (island)*
 - *use it to talk to people far away (telephone)*
 - *the opposite of big (small)*
 - *I came here train (by)*
- Give each person a copy of the key to their own crossword (A or B) so they can write the clues in the spaces provided. They may help each other within their own group, but everybody should write. They do not all have to write the same clues.
 - While they are writing, you should circulate to help and make corrections. If necessary, remind them to write legibly.
 - When they have written all the clues, collect the crosswords and distribute them to members of the other group, without the keys, so members of group B can solve crossword A, and visa versa.
 - Re-distribute the keys afterwards so they can check their answers.
