

## Ask about their new life

(Writing and reading)

- Description:** Writing questions about a text.
- Use with or after:** *English Network Plus (New Edition)*, Unit 1.
- Skill:** Vocabulary
- Focus:** Further exploitation of the text “A new life abroad” on page 10 of *English Network Plus (New Edition)*.
- Time:** 10 minutes
- Preparation:**
- Print out the second page of this file and make a copy for each student.
  - Cut on the dotted line to remove the key (suggested questions).
- Procedure:**
- Distribute the worksheets and ask the students to open their books at page 10.
  - Students refer to the text and write the eight questions on the worksheet. They should do this individually, and then compare their questions with a partner.
  - Distribute the key (suggested questions). If the students have variations, you should check that they are correct.
