

Unit 9 Part B: Running dictation: In the classroom

Unit:	Unit 9 Part B
Skill:	Reading, writing, listening and speaking
Focus:	<i>Must / mustn't</i>
Time:	20 minutes
Before the lesson:	Print out four copies of the Student's sheet.
In class:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explain that students are going to do a dictation where <i>they</i> do the dictating themselves. The students have to reproduce the text <i>In the classroom</i>. • Pin the four copies of the dictation on the four walls of the classroom. • Divide the class into four groups so that only one group is using each dictation. Each group should choose a runner. • The runners leave their seats and go to the text pinned on the wall. They read and memorise as much of the text as possible (and it's important they don't use any pens or paper to help them). They return to the group, where they dictate the sentence. The runner returns to the dictation on the wall, memorises the next part of the text, returns and dictates to the group. This carries on until the whole dictation has been reproduced. • When all the groups have finished, take the pinned dictations off the wall and distribute them to each group to check for corrections.
